

White Americans (79.7%) and Black Americans (17.0%) are most impacted by opioid-related deaths.

Opioid treatment programs are <u>limited</u> in many states with the <u>highest</u> rates of opioid-related overdose deaths: Alaska, Arkansas, Mississippi, North Dakota, Vermont, Wyoming and D.C.

Treatment of OUD can cost between \$5,980/year for suboxone and \$6,552/ year for methadone treatments and Naltrexone treatments can cost up to \$14,112/year
