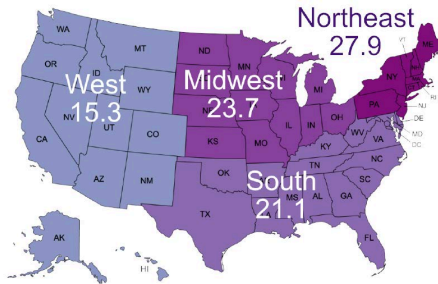
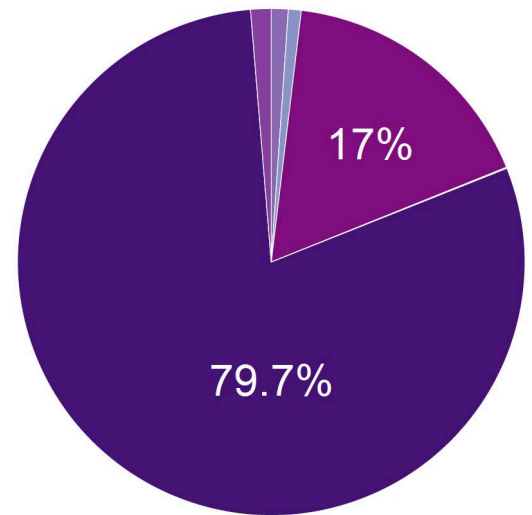


Opioid-related overdose death rates by region:

- 27.9% Northeast
- 23.7% Midwest
- 21.1% South
- 15.3% West



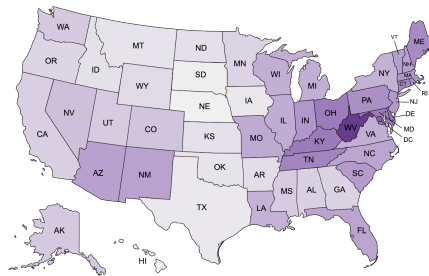
Percentage of Opioid-Related Deaths by Race, 2020



White Americans (79.7%) and Black Americans (17.0%) are most impacted by opioid-related deaths.

Opioid-related overdose deaths (per 100k) are located primarily in the Southern region:

- 70.0 West Virginia
- 40.4 Maryland
- 40.2 Kentucky
- 36.7 Tennessee



Opioid treatment programs are **limited** in many states with the **highest** rates of opioid-related overdose deaths: Alaska, Arkansas, Mississippi, North Dakota, Vermont, Wyoming and D.C.

Treatment of OUD can cost between \$5,980/year for suboxone and \$6,552/year for methadone treatments and Naltrexone treatments can cost up to \$14,112/year
