MORE RESEARCH IS NEEDED

Though more research is desperately needed, what research does exist suggests that pyomyositis should be suspected in all immunocompromised patients complaining of muscle pain and may exhibit signs of localized muscle infection.

It is estimated that 40,000 patients die of IED annually, in particular from E. coli sepsis. Older adults who develop healthcare-associated infections are believed to be at greatest risk of mortality from IED.
