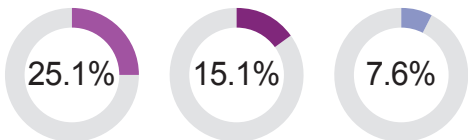
Reported Having a Major Depressive Episode (2021):

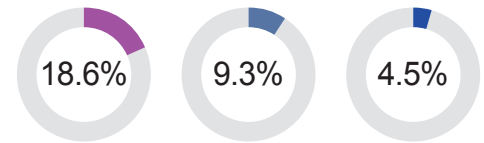
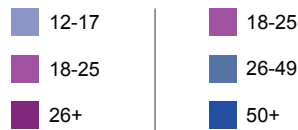

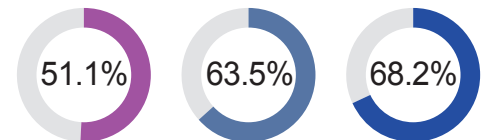
